Paddle Pass Policy

All Social and Full Members may store a small boat at CIYC as long as the following criteria are met and understood:

- a) The boat must be rack storable and fit on the racks provided on the property.
- The boat must be owned by and under the control of the member. A member must accompany a guest when using a small boat.
- c) Boats must be removed from the mast racks four (4) weeks before haul out and may not be stored there until the masts have been removed at the beginning of the season.
- d) Storage will be subject to available space and will be determined by the execuitive. Any member who stores a small boat at the Club will have priority for storage the following year.
- Members may be assigned more than one rack subject to available space.
- The Club will not be responsible for loss or damage to the small boats
- g) Rake storable boats my be stored at the club on racks over the winter as long as the mast racks are kept free and clear...
- A fee will charged as outlined in Small Boat Storage under "Additional Fees and Charges Schedule"
