Dock Report for 2024 AGM

## 2024 Season

April 27<sup>th</sup> 2024 – Launch completed.

New Pump Out installed along with storage shed at the Gyn Pole Dock – Thank you to Warren Ritchie, Craig Canniff and crew!

October 26<sup>th</sup> 2024 – Haul out proved to be somewhat difficult this year as a different crane was sent out for the South yard than had been used in previous years and due to lack of counterweights (despite being a larger crane) could not reach to spots previously reached by the crane normally sent. This resulted in some shuffling of boats, etc., this has been discussed with Moir Crane and they will try and ensure that the 90T crane comes back for spring launch 2025 or that the crane comes out with adequate counter weights.

Launch is set and booked for April 26<sup>th</sup> 2025.

Dock boards...a reminder to all members to ensure your dock boards are out. They were supposed to be removed by November 1<sup>st</sup> to avoid a penalty and having the boards removed by the Dock Committee. I have extended this to November 16<sup>th</sup> after which they will be removed and possibly un-useable due to removal methods.

## 2025 Season

Docks for 2025 is somewhat of a challenge due to the number of new applications we have seen with 30'+ boats. This will require a shuffle of existing docks for some members, as always your understanding of having to change docks is really appreciated as it is a challenge fitting everyone. For the 2025 season it appears (for now) that we are full up – again!

Please refrain from using 4" x 4" or 6" x 6" dock posts, they already make a tight well space tighter – please use 2" x 6" or 2" x 4" dock boards only. In the future CIYC will be working on installing and supplying uniform dock boards that are permanently installed.
