- 1. Price is in for new shed total including taxes \$3,753.86 to be delivered and installed after cradle day and spring clean-up. The plan is to move existing shed over to South end of club house for ease of installation from North parking lot.
- 2. Mark Woodrow still available for lawn maintenance. New contract to be signed. I propose to offer him an extra \$15.00 for a total of \$95.00 per service.
- 3. Green Marine: containers are in the process of being labelled, should be ready next week. They will be stored beside the garbage bin. Sorb-All type of dessicant material for spills will be stored in the back shed. P&P's from Warren to be reviewed.
- 4. Clean-up day to be scheduled for Saturday May 13. Schedule of duties to be posted.
- 5. A schedule will be created and posted for people to sign up for weekly club cleaning work hours during sailing season. (I am suggesting allocation of 2.5 hours per cleaning)
- 6. Ontario Food Premises Regulations Exemption: Will try to get proper signage from ministry to post. Log book for serving food still outstanding will be ready for 1st event.
- 7. I called approximately 75% of new members to introduce myself as Property Officer and Vice Commodore and to solicit for work hours. I haven't identified anyone with particular skills set of trades but I lined up some help for the property maintenance.
- 8. Discussion, Idea to draw new membership: to offer membership at reduced fee of \$1200.00 instead of \$1500.00 to be paid for with work hours, an extra 40 hours over and above the current yearly 20 hours, and to be allowed 2 years to complete. This 2 year period to be their probation time.
